APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Postmark deadline is March 13, 2009. Each entrant must please submit the following:

1. An email or CD with five jpeg images representing the work to be exhibited at *ArtFest*
 2. Current, **1-page** resume
 3. Completed application form
 4. \$15.00 jury fee; make check or money order payable to the **Northwest Museum of Arts & Culture**. Emails will not be considered until jury fee is received.
 5. **IF RETURN OF IMAGES IS DESIRED**, enclose a self-addressed, stamped envelope that will accommodate your material.
- IMPORTANT: Jpegs must be a minimum of 4 x 6 inches at 300 pixels per square inch on a PC compatible disk. Generally images between 300 KB and one full MB are satisfactory. Sorry, we can't accept slides or photographs. Give each jpeg digital image a number and match it to the "Image Listing" on this page.**

Jury notification will be no later than April 10, 2009. Detailed information regarding *ArtFest* will accompany notification of accepted artists. Following acceptance, *ArtFest* registration must be postmarked no later than **May 1, 2009** and must be accompanied by the entry fee of \$350, a booth fee of \$50 for a 10' x 10' booth space or \$60 for a 10' x 15' booth space (a limited number of 10' x 15' booths are available). A \$20 fee is required of artists requiring electrical hookup. The booth structure must fit within the confines of the designated space; no part, including tent cords, can extend past these boundaries. **Only artists collaborating on a body of work will be allowed to share a booth and must be pre-approved (prior to May 30) by ArtFest Committee Chairs.** Invited artists will be allowed to exhibit **only** the body of work accepted. The jury selects approximately one hundred and thirty artists as well as two alternates in each category from submitted images.

RESTRICTIONS

All artwork must be original from concept through completion. No commercial production (such as commercial bisque ware) or student work will be accepted. Reproductions may not constitute more than 10% of the total work shown, and the originals of the reproduction must be exhibited. Reproductions must be clearly labeled as such for *ArtFest* patrons. This does **not** mean that artists may reproduce their artwork on magnets, calendars, mouse pads, etc. and sell them at *ArtFest*. More complete guidelines regarding reproductions will be mailed to accepted artists. If any commercially made parts are utilized, they must constitute only a small percentage of each piece. We encourage artists to be present. Artist's partners are acceptable; however, agents and dealers are not allowed. All restrictions will be enforced by the *ArtFest* Committee.

FEES

- Jury Fee \$15—Due March 13
- Entry Fee \$350—Due upon acceptance, May 1. This year a flat fee is required; there will be no commission sales.
- Booth Fee \$50 (for 10'x10') \$60 (for 10'x15'). Due upon acceptance, May 1.
- Electric Fee (if needed)—\$20. Due upon acceptance, May 1.
